J.L. MORENO AWARDS FOR RESEARCH IN PSYCHODRAMA CRITERIA

1. DENOMINATION

J.L. Moreno Prize for RESEARCH IN PSYCHODRAMA.

2. OBJECT

The Prizes will be awarded to research work on PSYCHODRAMA among those who appear as candidates.

2.1. Such works can be presented in two modalities:

2.1.1. Full Research Work.

2.1.2. Research Project (Runner-up), for works that are still in this phase.

2.1.3. Therefore, it follows that a work cannot participate in both modalities (complete research work and runner-up).

2.2. Such works must have applied the SCIENTIFIC METHODOLOGY in its quantitative or qualitative aspect.

2.3. Under no circumstances may works infringe the copyright or intellectual property of third parties.

2.4. Works that are being subsidized by other scientific entities, of public or private nature, may not be eligible for these prizes.

2.5. Moreover, doctoral theses will not be eligible for these awards, as they are often the subject of prizes in the academic field.



3. ENDOWMENT

3.1. The economic endowment of the prizes, according to the different modalities, is:

Modality	1st Prize	2nd Prize
Full Research Work	500 €	200€
Research Project (Runner-up)	100€	

3.2. An Honorable Mention will also be awarded to the 3rd and 4th placed works in the **Full Research Work** and to the 2nd placed work in the **Research Project (Runner-up)**.

3.3. The jury may decide to distribute the Prize amount between a maximum of 2 winners per category, until the budget for the call is exhausted (full work in its first and second prize and research project).

3.4. Likewise, the jury will have the power to declare the prize desert.

4. SUBMISSION OF THE PAPERS

The work must be submitted within the deadline established in these bases and must be sent by EMAIL.

4.1. The deadline will be 23h59 on the last day (Madrid time).

4.2. Applicants must consider the following points when submitting their work:

4.2.1) The works may have one or several authors, and it should be identified on the Title Page whether there is a principal investigator.

4.2.2) Manuscripts should be prepared according to the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (A.P.A. 6th ed.), must be accompanied by a bibliography, also according to the norms of the A.P.A., 6th ed., and must have the extension, including references/bibliography:

- **Full Research Work:** minimum of 15 and maximum of 25 pages;

- **Research Project (Runner-up):** minimum of 10 and maximum of 15 pages.



4.2.3) The work must be sent to the following recipient: Jury Secretary, Miryam Soler: president@aep.es, with the following information in the subject: J.L. Moreno Awards

4.2.4) The work must be sent by email in Word and PDF format.

4.2.5) The format of the presentation must be A4, vertical, 2,5 cm margins, throughout the entire manuscript. The font used must be Arial 12, double spacing, and typed on a single face.

4.2.6) The pages must be numbered, including the annexes that accompany the work.

4.2.7) All manuscripts must include a table of contents and have the figures in each of the pages in which they are mentioned, not at the end, as in other publications.

4.2.8) Manuscripts must contain the following:

a) Title Page:

- a1) Title
- a2) Name of all the authors
- a3) Affiliation of all authors
- a4) Email of all the authors
- a5) Name of the author who is the principal investigator (if any)

b) Table of Contents

c) Abstract page:

- c1) Abstract in Spanish
- c2) Keywords in Spanish
- c3) Abstract in English
- c4) Keywords in English

d) Manuscript

- d1) Introduction
 - d1.1) Title
 - d1.2) Introduction to the research problem
 - d1.3) Antecedents, if any



d1.4) Objectives, justification of their need or convenience

e) Method

- e.1) Participants
- e.2) Instruments and/or materials
- e.3) Procedures
- e.4) Results
- e.5) Discussion

f) References/Bibliography

4.2.9) Papers written in Spanish or English are accepted.

4.2.10) The work must not contain any direct or indirect identification of the name or affiliation of the contestant (for example, it must refer to “a center of southern Spain” instead of “Centro Sevillano de Psicoterapias”), or through the notes and acknowledgment.

5. CONTESTANTS

Eligible for this prize are all professionals who have had the opportunity to conduct research on psychodrama or intend to carry out a research project on psychodrama. Therefore, professionals in the fields of psychology, medicine, social sciences, education and any other discipline to which psychodrama may apply.

6. PUBLICATION IN THE LA HOJA DE PSICODRAMA AEP JOURNAL

The winners will be invited to present their work for review by editors and subsequent publication in the La Hoja de Psicodrama AEP journal.

6.1. As such, they must agree to make the changes proposed by the reviewers.

7. JURY

The jury for these awards will include three psychodramatists, two of which are from the AEP-Asociación Española de Psicodrama (Spanish Association of Psychodrama), as well as one external psychodramatist. In addition, the President of the AEP (or the person to which she/he delegates the role of participating jury) shall be part of the jury.

8. DEADLINE:

June 15, 2020 (until 23h59min).



9. NON-COMPLIANCE

Failure to comply with any of the preceding clauses is grounds for exclusion of the work.

Any exclusion will only be communicated at the end of the process.

10. APPEAL

There will be no appeal against the decision of the jury, which may decide not to award the Prize if the defined requirements are not met.

11. JUDGEMENT of the JURY: The communication to the contestants will be made on September 30, 2021 and the jury's decision will be presented at the opening ceremony of the XXXV Psychodrama Congress, October 2021.
